Accident Classification

Did the accident originate from some risk connected with or incidental to the worker's employment?

- ☐ **Yes, the accident was distinctly associated with employment.**

- ☐ **No, the cause of the accident was personal to the worker.**

Did the accident occur in the course of employment?

Time of Accident

Circumstances of Accident
